

No Limits Eastern Shore's Guidelines for Accessibility Evaluation

NLES' guidelines for accessibility evaluation are based off of the 2013 Forest Service Trail Accessibility Guidelines (FSTAG 2013) and the 2013 Forest Service Outdoor Recreation Accessibility Guidelines (FSORAG 2013) which were developed as legally enforceable standards for outdoor recreation areas/trails registered in the National Forest System. Each trail evaluated will be given a final grade of green, yellow, or red using the following scoring guidelines:

Accessibility Key	
Green	Very accessible, smooth surface, little to no grade incline, few/no obstacles, access to a wide range of features.
Yellow	Moderately accessible, minimally rough surface, slight grade incline, few obstacles, minimal access to features.
Red	Not accessible, rough terrain, significant slopes, many obstacles, little/no access to features.
